

## New records of lacebugs from the Palaearctic part of Asia (Heteroptera: Tingidae)

16 species are recorded for the first time from various countries of Asia.

The paper is based on the collections of the Zoological Institute, St. Petersburg. The following abbreviations are used: AF – Afghanistan, AR – Armenia, AK – Kazakhstan (Asiatic part), TM – Turkmenistan. All records are the first ones for respective countries.

*Campylosteira bosnica* Horváth, 1892. Russia, N Caucasus: 4 specimens (3 of them badly damaged), Pyatigorsk, 8.V.1928, 1.IV.1937 (Rysakov).

*Campylosteira eximia* Horváth, 1892. AK: 1♀, Kzyl-Orda, 24.IV.1905 (Oshanin). TM: 1♀, Murgab Distr., Teze-Durmush, 3.VI.1971 (Kamalov); 1♂, 5♀, Iolatan', 21.III.1927 (Kizeritskiy). China: 1♀, NE Xinjiang, Nanshankou, N of Hami, 27.V.1877 (Potanin).

*Campylosteira orientalis* Horváth, 1881. AR: 1♀, Kirovakan [= Vanadzor], 13.VII.1956 (Gevorkian).

*Acalypta hellenica* Reuter, 1888. AR: 1♀, Ashtarak Distr., gorge of Kazakh River, 16.V.1957 (Trjapitzin).

*Dictyonota halimodendri* Golub, 1975. AK: 1♂, 35 km NW of Kegen, Charyn River, 15.VII.1986 (Volkovich).

*Kalama coriacea* (Asanova, 1970). TM: 1♀, W Kopetdag, Aydere gorge, 12.V.1979 (Fet).

*Derephysia bucharensis* Josifov, 1969. TM: 6♂, 5♀, Badhyz Nature Reserve, Kzyl-Dzhar, 5.VI.1972 (Golub), on *Artemisia (Seriphidium)* sp.

*Derephysia gracilicornis* Josifov, 1969. TM: 1♂, Badhyz Nature Reserve, Kzyl-Dzhar, 6.VI.1972 (Golub), on the same plant as *D. bucharensis*.

*Derephysia minuta* Josifov, 1969. AK: 1♀, Akkum, 200 km SE of Kzyl-Orda, 30.V.1996 (Kerzhner).

*Tingis* (s. str.) *rotundicollis* (Jakovlev, 1883). TM: 1♀, 1 larva, Kopetdagh, env. of Karakala, 1300-1400 m, 29.VI.1983 (Sugonjaev). – *T. rotundicollis* and *T. grisea* Germar, 1835 are considered good species by Horváth (1906) and other authors (for distinguishing characters see Golub, 1977), but as synonyms by Putshkov (1974) and Péricart (1983). None of these species was recorded from TM.

*Tingis* (s. str.) *leptochila* Horváth, 1906. Kirgizia: 1♂, Central Tien-Shan, 80 km W of Naryn (Emeljanov).

*Tingis* (s. str.) *zhadiana* Golub, 1978. AK: Ushtobe near Taldy-Kurgan; Ulanbel' on Chu River. TM: Great

Balkhan Mts. AF: Baglan.

*Tingis* (s. str.) *demissa* Horváth, 1906. AR: 1♀, Erevan, 1.XI.1931 (Korinek).

*Tingis* (s. str.) *suavis* Horváth, 1902. Uzbekistan: 1♀, Shirabad, 1912 (Siyazov); 2♀, Termez, 9, 24.V.1912 (Kiritshenko); 1♀, 40 km NW of Dzhingildy (Narshuk).

*Tingis* (*Neolasiotropis*) *ottomana* Péricart & Önder, 1982. Iran: 17 specimens, Shahkuh, 22.VI, 5.VII.1914 (Kiritshenko)..

*Dictyla concinna* Golub, 1979. AK: 2♂, 1♀, Dzhambul Prov., 25 km SW of Otar, 9.VI.1978 (Kerzhner).

*Monosteira lobulifera* Reuter, 1888. TM: 5♂, 4♀, Repetek, 6.VI.1962 (Trjapitzin).

*Monosteira tuberculata* Péricart, 1981. AF: 6♂, 5♀, 40 km W of Djelalabad, 23.VII.1966 (Sugonjaev).
